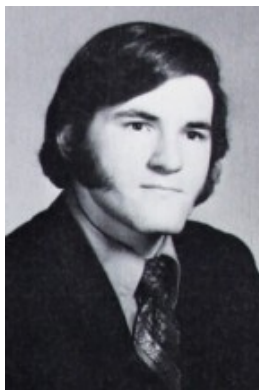
Family: 1 daughter - Keia Blair; born 1990 divorced in 2001. Married Belinda in 2022
