
Family: Wife Barb, wed 35 years; son Nicholas, Music Teacher; daughter Erica, Biologist

Occupation: Currently a Proud Grandmother


Family: We have 2 daughters, 1 son 2 in-laws + a Granddaughter Westie & Grand Golden
