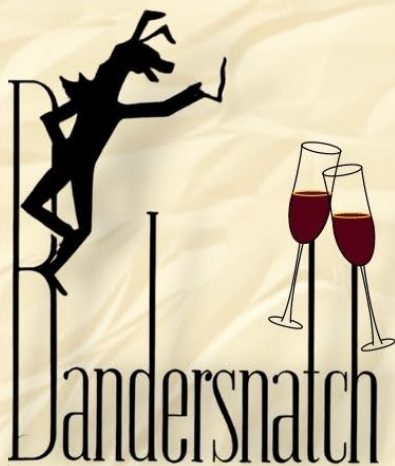

So I am utilizing this opportunity to thank each of them, and make sure that you are aware of who participated on your reunion 60th/61st committee:

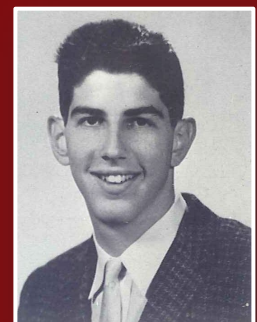
